The CLP has delivered, itself and with a range of partners, over 300 courses since June 2006. It is not possible, in the short time available to provide a list of for each year. The courses have ranged from 2-week intensive courses to 1 day and half-day courses with varying costs. Again it is not possible to detail each course in the time available, however, the average cost for the 2-week intensive, for example was £4,100

The estimated cost for the Alumni gathering on 11 Sept is £10,000.

The CLP has spent in the region of £140,000 on approx 30 conferences, seminars and events since 2006. These have included a mixture of full day and half day events. A breakdown by year is not possible in the short time available.
