The Communications Act

The Communications Act received Royal Assent in July 2003. It is a major reform of regulation in the communications sector and provides a regulatory framework that can respond to the market as it changes and will safeguard the interest of citizens and consumers. OFCOM, the new communications regulator, formally opened for business in December 2003.
