The Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport has appointed Alexis Redmond as a Trustee of the National Museums Liverpool. The four year appointment began on 24 July 2003.

Biographical Details

Alexis Redmond is the Managing Director of Mersey Television Group Limited. She is a qualified chartered accountant, with extensive experience of business and management as well as experience in media, public relations and community relations.

Ms Redmond has served on the Boards of several institutions, in both paid and unpaid capacities. She recently retired from the Liverpool John Moores University Board of Governors, on which she served for ten years, as Chair of Finance and as Deputy Chair of the Board. She is currently Chair of the Audit Committee for the Riverside Group Limited, one of the largest social landlords in the country; Chair of the Audit Committee at the Merseyside Special Investment Fund Limited, a company which provides funding support for small and medium sized businesses with loans and equity packages; and a trustee at St George's Hall Charitable Trust.

Ms Redmond has not carried out any political activity in the last five years.
